



2024 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

We're not partisan, but we are passionate in our mission to build strong cities for a stronger West Virginia.

The West Virginia Municipal League Legislative Committee has identified these legislative priorities:

Amendments to Municipal Court payment plans

- Allow DL suspension for payment plans with no contact for six months.
- Allow City Attorneys and Muni Court Clerks to file liens.
- Exempt court collections from a section of collection law.

Increase Threshold for Property Auction

- Increase from \$1K to \$10K.
- Allow sale of property to adjoining owners without auction.

Increase Threshold for Construction Bids

- Increase threshold from \$25k to \$50K for government construction and Municipal Public Works projects.
